2. DISCIPLINARY HEARING:

NEVADA PLASTERING, INC. LICENSE NO. 48203 (Continued from January 22, 2004, February 24, 2004, March 9, 2004 and April 6, 2004)

Licensee was present with counsel, Richard Reed.

Hearing Officer Zech found the respondent Nevada Plastering, Inc., Anthony Gonzalez, President, license number 48203 in violation of the Decision and Order dated January 29, 2004. License number 48203, Nevada Plastering, Inc. was Revoked. The revocation is stayed if Mr. Gonzalez pays the Campbells the settlement agreement in the amount of \$23,204.50 and reimburses the Board for investigative costs of \$3,229.00 within 90 days from May 18, 2004. If the Campbells are not paid or the Board not reimbursed, license number 48203, Nevada Plastering, Inc. will automatically be Revoked. License number 48203, Nevada Plastering, Inc. will be placed on probation for one (1) year if Mr. Gonzalez complies with the Decision and Order. During the probation period, Mr. Gonzalez shall furnish copies of all building permits for all projects undertaken within ten (10) days; shall furnish copies of all contracts entered into within ten (10) days; shall comply with all federal, state and local laws governing licensed contractors; and shall appear in person for interviews with the Director of Investigations or designee upon request and with reasonable notice. Upon successful completion of the probation, license number 48203, Nevada Plastering, Inc. shall be fully restored. If Mr. Gonzalez violates probation in any respect, the Executive Officer after giving notice may revoke probation and impose the disciplinary order that was stayed.
