Ms. Grein called the workshop to order and explained the purpose of the workshop is to received public comment on the proposed regulation to amend Chapter 624 of the Nevada Administrative Code to eliminate the subcategories in the C 5 classification and combine all work to be performed under the C-5 classification; licensees holding a C 5(b) classification would be limited to concrete cutting. The proposed regulation also proposes to eliminate C 32; C34 and C 35 classifications and to issue those licensees designated C 40 license classifications. Ms. Grein indicated that the notice of the workshop had been posted in compliance with NRS 233B at the Las Vegas City Hall, the Sawyer State Building, Clark County Library, Washoe County Courthouse, Washoe County Library, Reno City Hall and the offices of the State Contractors Board in Reno and Henderson.

There were several members of the Nevada Landscape Association present to request information concerning the appropriate classification for the installation of pavers.

Ms. Cavin explained that comments expressed at the workshop must be limited to the content of the regulation. An informal meeting will be convened with members of the Landscape Association to discuss their concerns.

Mr. Dave Kagle, representing American Refractories and Mr. Mike Colven, of Concrete Inc. were present in the Henderson office. Neither offered comment.

There being no further comments, the workshop was adjourned.
