Hearing Officer Cavin found Respondent Warner Brothers Construction, license number 56842 guilty of violating NRS 624.3017(1) substandard workmanship; NRS 624.3013(5), as set forth in NRS 624.700(3)(a) failure to comply with the Board's Notice to Correct; NRS 624.3015(1) acting in the capacity of a contractor beyond the scope of the license; NRS 624.3011(2) ; NRS 624.3015(2) bidding to contract or contracting for a sum for one construction project in excess of the limit placed on the license by the Board; NRS 624.700 engaging in business or submitting a bid without a license; NRS 624.3013(4) failure to keep in full force the bond or cash deposit pursuant to NRS 624.270 for the full period required by the Board; NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility. License number 56842 was revoked. Prior to relicensure Respondent shall pay a fine of \$14,000.00 and investigative costs of \$2,107.00 and pay full restitution to the damaged parties.
