OSHA 7105 – Evacuation & Emergency Planning [48448] - This course focuses on the OSHA requirements for emergency action plans and fire protection plans. Individuals will learn the importance of preparing for emergencies which is a basic principle of workplace safety and health. Topics covered include (1) reasons for emergency action plans and fire prevention plans and when they are required for the workplace; (2) elements of

a good evacuation plan; and (3) features of design and maintenance of good exit routes. The course material covers all types of emergencies from natural disasters, fire, man-made disasters and more. Monday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Aug. 18, 2008. Cost \$200.
