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<u>CONTRACTORS BOARD TAKES DISCIPLINARY ACTION</u> <u>AGAINST SEVEN CONTRACTORS</u>

(*Henderson, NV*) - At its meeting on September 30, 2003, the Nevada State Contractors Board adjudicated cases against seven (7) licensed contractors.

Reiger Construction Co. Inc, license number 23383 (General Building) based out of Las Vegas, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to pay for materials or services; failure to cooperate in the investigation of a complaint; and failure to establish financial responsibility. The Board revoked the license of Reiger Construction Co. Inc.

Principle Centered Inc dba Legacy Homes, license number 51166 (Residential and Small Commercial) based out of Las Vegas, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for substandard workmanship; failure to comply with a notice to correct; failure to cooperate in the investigation of a complaint; and failure to report to the Board a change in address or personnel. The Board revoked the license of Principle Centered Inc. dba Legacy Homes.

Unique Plastering Inc dba Unique Plastering LTD, license number 39130 (Lathing and Plastering) based out of Las Vegas, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to notify the Board of a bankruptcy; failure to notify the Board of a change in address or personnel; failure to keep in force a bond or cash deposit; and failure to establish financial responsibility. The Board revoked the license of Unique Plastering Inc dba Unique Plastering LTD.

Cane Development, license number 44659 (Residential and Small Commercial) based out of Henderson, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to pay for materials or services; failure to establish financial responsibility; failure to comply with a written request by the Board; failure to report to the Board a change in address or personnel; failure to provide required list of subcontractors; failure to provide required contract disclosures; failure to include license number and monetary limit on a contract or proposal; and failure to keep in force a bond or cash deposit. The Board revoked the license of Cane Development.

Performance Underground, license number 47366 (Electrical Conduits) based out of Las Vegas, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to pay for materials or services; failure to cooperate in the investigation of a complaint; failure to establish financial responsibility; and failure to keep in force a bond or cash deposit. The Board revoked the license of Performance Underground.

Howard William Ickes, license number 44765a (Residential and Small Commercial) based out of Las Vegas, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for substandard workmanship and failure to comply with a notice to correct. Licensee was assessed the cost of investigation.

Deznan Contractors Incorporated, license number 26413 (Residential and Small Commercial) based out of Las Vegas, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for substandard workmanship and failure to comply with a notice to correct. Licensee was fined \$2,000 and assessed the cost of investigation.

The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare through licensing and regulation of the construction industry. Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor's license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine of up to \$10,000 per offense, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.
