REVISED PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 624.220.

Section 1. NAC 624.280 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 624.280 [1]. The Board will grant to qualified applicants a license in the specialty of landscape contracting. The Board designates such a license as a "classification C-10" license. A person who holds a classification C-10 license may:
 - [(a)] 1. Grade and prepare plots of land for architectural horticulture;
- [(b)] 2. Decoratively treat, arrange, plant and maintain gardens, lawns, shrubs, vines, bushes, trees and other vegetation;
 - [(c)]-3. Construct systems of drainage and landscape irrigation; [and]
 - [(d)] 4. Install rocks, sand and gravel for desert landscaping \square ;
- [(e)] 5. Install nonload-bearing walkways using brick or stone not exceeding 200 square feet in area;
 - [(f)] 6. Install patio areas using brick or stone not exceeding 400 square feet in area; and
 - [(g)] 7. Install landscape retaining walls to a height not exceeding [two] three feet.
 - 8. Install non-engineered decorative landscape ponds.
 - 9. Install landscape lighting not to exceed 24 volts.

- 10. Install non-engineered, prefabricated trellises and arbors.
- 11. Perform hydroseeding and soil erosion control by spraying mulch, seeds and nutrients under pressure; or using other methods of soil erosion control, including the application of netting.
- [2. The subclassifications of the classification C-10 license and the work authorized for persons licensed in the respective subclassifications are:
- (a) LANDSCAPING (subclassification C-10a): All work authorized by a classification C-10 license except the installation of drainage and landscape irrigation systems.
- (b) LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION (subclassification C-10b): The installation of systems of drainage and landscape irrigation for lawns and shrubs.
- (c) HYDROSEEDING AND CONTROL OF SOIL EROSION (subclassification C-10c): The implantation of ground cover by spraying mulch, seeds and nutrients under pressure and the use of other methods of controlling soil erosion, including the application of netting.]
