Hearing Officer Clark found Respondent Robert Chandler, dba Custom Sheet Metal Fabrication, license number 36492 guilty of NRS 624.3017(1) substandard workmanship; NRS 624.3013(5) as set forth in NAC 624.700(3) failure to comply with Notice to Correct; NRS 624.3013(5) as set forth in NAC 624.640(5) failure to include license number and monetary limit on contracts; NRS 624.3013(5) as set forth in NRS 624.520(1) failure to provide Residential Recovery Fund notice to owner; NRS 624.301(5) willful failure to refusal without legal excuse on the part of a licensee to comply with the terms of a construction contract or written warranty, thereby causing material injury to another; NRS 624.3011(1)(a) disregard of plans or specifications without the consent of the owner; NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility. Mr. Chandler was assessed a total fine of \$1,000.00 for the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth and Seventh Causes of Action. Investigative Costs were assessed in the amount of \$700.00. The Respondent was ordered to pay restitution to the homeowner in the amount of \$4,500.00. Mr. Chandler is to required to pay full restitution and pay Fines and Costs within 60 days from September 8, 2004 or license number 36492, Robert Chandler, dba Custom Sheet Metal Fabrication will automatically be Suspended.
