

Ms. Grein explained the purpose of the workshop is to receive public comment on proposed amendments to Chapter 624 of the Nevada Administrative Code changing certain administrative fine amounts and outlining circumstances for which the maximum fine may be assessed. The regulation has been assigned R-118-06 by the Legislative Counsel Bureau.

Ms. Grein indicated that the notice of the workshop and hearing had been posted in compliance with NRS 233B at the Las Vegas City Hall, the Sawyer State Building, Clark County Library, Washoe County Courthouse, Washoe County Library, Reno City Hall and the offices of the State Contractors Board in Reno and Henderson.

Since there were no members of the public present to provide comments, Ms. Grein closed the workshop and opened the hearing. Ms. Grein stated the notice of hearing was posted in accordance with the Open Meeting Law. She indicated that since no comments were received at the workshop the regulation would be placed on the June 15, 2006 Board meeting agenda for Board action.
