Licensee was not present nor represented by counsel.

Hearing Officer Schaefer found Respondent R. K. Rue, Inc., dba C. D. I., Frederick Knight, President, license numbers 63774, and dba The Affordable Handyman, License number 67293 guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.3012(2) willful failure to pay any money when due for materials or service; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(4) failure to keep bond in force; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3018(2) certain persons are prohibited from serving as officer, director, associate or partner of licensee; two (2) violations of NRS 624.3015(1) acting beyond scope of license; two (2) violations of NRS 624.3013(5) as set forth in NAC 624.640(5) each licensee shall include in all bids he submits or contracts he enters into for construction work within this State, the number of the license and any monetary limit placed upon his license. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$3,000.00 for the First Cause of Action, a fine for \$1,000.00 for each of the Second and Fifth Causes of Action and a fine of \$2,000.00 for the Fourth Cause of Action for total fines due of \$7,000.00. Respondent was found in violation of the Sixth and Seventh Causes of Action however no fine was assessed. The investigative costs were assessed in the amount of \$2,463.00. License number 63774, R. K. Rue, Inc., dba C. D. I., and license number 67293, R. K. Rue, Inc., dba The Affordable Handyman, were revoked. Mr. Knight is required to pay full restitution to the damaged parties and reimburse the Board for any monies paid out of Residential Recovery fund plus fines and investigative costs prior to consideration of future licensure.

4. DISCIPLINARY HEARING - DEFAULT ORDERS

a. NEVADA STATE BUILDERS, INC., LICENSE NO. 58489

Licensee was not present.

Hearing Officer Schaefer found Respondent Nevada State Builders, Inc., Steven P. Strang, Vice President, license number 58489, in default and adopted the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as set forth in the Administrative complaint. Mr. Stang was found guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.305(1) no license may be used for any purpose by any person other than the person to whom license is issued; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3014(a),(b),(c) and (d) aiding and abetting an unlicensed person to evade the provisions of this chapter; combining or conspiring with an unlicensed person to perform an unauthorized act; allowing a license to be used by an unlicensed person; acting as agent, partner or associate of an unlicensed person; one (1) violation of NRS 624.301(1) abandonment of construction project; one (1) violation of NRS 624.301(4) failure to prosecute a construction project with reasonable diligence; one (1) violation of NRS 624.301(2) abandonment of construction project when percentage completed is less than percentage of total contract paid; one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(5) failure to comply with a written request by the Board; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3012(3) failure to obtain the discharge or release of any lien recorded against the property; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3012(1) diversion of money; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5) as set forth in NAC 624.640(5) each licensee shall include in all bids he submits or contracts he enters into for construction work within this State, the number of the license and any monetary limit placed upon his license; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5) as set forth in NAC 624.640(3) failure to notify Board of change of address or personnel; one (1) violation of NRS.624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$10,000.00. The investigative costs were assessed in the amount of \$2,321.00. Respondent shall make restitution to Frank Bean in the amount of \$102,499.62 and to Delish Café & Java Bar in the amount of \$121,857.24. License number 58489, Nevada State Builders, Inc., was revoked. Mr. Strang is required to pay full restitution to all damaged parties and reimburse the Board for any monies paid out of Residential Recovery fund plus fines and investigative costs prior to consideration of future licensure.

b. ALL STAR LANDSCAPING CORPORATION, LICENSE NO. 59196

Licensee was not present.

Hearing Officer Schaefer found Respondent All Star Landscaping Corporation, Patrick Ware Robinson, President, license number 59196, in default and adopted the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as set forth in the Administrative complaint. Mr. Robinson was found guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.3011(1) (b) (4) willful disregard of the industrial insurance laws of the State; one (1) violation of NRS 624.302(5) failure to comply with a written request by the Board; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5) as set forth in NAC 624.640(5) each licensee shall include in all bids he submits or contracts he enters into for construction work within this State, the number of the license and any monetary limit placed upon his license; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility: one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5) as set forth in NRS 624.300 failure to comply with an order from the Board. License number 59196, All Star Landscaping Corporation was revoked. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$2,500.00. Investigative costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,362.00. Mr. Robinson is required to pay full restitution to all damaged parties and reimburse the Board for any monies paid out of the Residential Recovery fund plus fines and investigative costs prior to consideration of future licensure.

Licensee was not present.

Hearing Officer Schaefer found Respondent Under the Son Excavating, Inc., Mark Robert Franks, President, license number 55421, in default and adopted the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as set forth in the Administrative complaint. Mr. Franks was found guilty of one (1) violation of NRS 624.3011(1) (b) (2) willful disregard of the safety or labor laws of the State; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5) as set forth in NAC 624.640(3) failure to notify Board of change of address or personnel. License number 55421, Under the Son Excavating, Inc., was revoked. Mr. Franks was assessed a fine of \$1,750.00. Investigative costs were assessed in the amount of \$1,269.00. Mr. Franks is required to pay full restitution to all damaged parties and reimburse the Board for monies paid out of the Residential Recovery fund plus fines and investigative costs prior to consideration of future licensure.
