It was noted for the record that notice of the meeting had been properly posted in accordance with NRS 233B, the State's Open Meeting Law at the Reno City Hall; Washoe County Court House; Washoe County Library; Las Vegas City Hall; Sawyer State Building; Clark County Library; offices of the State Contractors Board, Reno and Henderson and on the Board's website.
