Hearing Officer Cavin found Respondent guilty of two (2) violations of NRS 624.3013(5), as set forth in NRS 624.520(1) failure to provide Residential Recovery Fund notice to owner; one (1) violation of one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(5), as set forth in NAC 624.640(5) failure to include its license number and monetary license limit on its contracts; two (2) violations of NRS 624.302(1)(a) contracting while the license has been suspended; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(4) failure to keep the bond in force for the full period required by the Board; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3013(3) failure to establish financial responsibility; one (1) violation of NRS 624.3015(1) acting in the capacity of a contractor beyond the scope of the license. Respondent was assessed a fine of \$100.00 each for the First, Second and Fourth Causes of Action; a fine of \$1,000.00 each for the Third and Seventh Causes of Action; a fine of \$250.00 for each of the Fifth and Eighth Causes of Action; a fine of \$500.00 for the Sixth Cause of Action for total fines of \$3,300.00 and investigative costs of \$3,068.00. Fines and investigative costs are due within ninety (90) days of the November 14, 2012 hearing or license number 44635, Ted Mount, Owner, dba Natural Energy shall be revoked. Respondent was ordered to submit a current compiled financial statement prepared by a Certified Public Accountant with bank verification forms for all cash accounts that support the license limit within thirty (30) days of the November 14, 2012 hearing or license number 44635, Ted Mount, Owner, dba Natural Energy shall remain suspended. If the fines and investigative costs are timely paid but a current compiled financial statement is not submitted within ninety (90) days of the November 14, 2012 hearing, the license limit shall be lowered to \$10,000.00 until a conforming financial statement is submitted that supports a higher license limit.
