## BOARD TAKES DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST TWO CONTRACTORS

(*Reno, NV*) – At its meeting on April 8, 2003 the Nevada State Contractors Board adjudicated cases against two (2) licensed contractors.

Advanced Construction, license number 46361 (Residential and Small Commercial) based out of Reno, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for substandard workmanship; failure to comply with a notice to correct; failure to include license number and monetary limit on a contract or proposal; and willful departure from plans or specifications. The licensee was fined \$3000 and assessed the cost of investigation.

**Best Contracting,** license number 39364 (Painting and Decorating) based out of Reno, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for abandonment of a construction project; failure to comply with the terms of a construction contract or warranty; and failure to include monetary limit on a contract or proposal. A permanent letter of reprimand was placed in the licensee's file; licensee was fined \$1000 and assessed the cost of investigation.

The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare through licensing and regulation of the construction industry. Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor's license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine of up to \$10,000 per offense, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.

The Board will convene next in Henderson, NV on April 22, 2003.
