## CONTRACTORS BOARD TAKES DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST FOUR CONTRACTORS

(*Reno, NV*) - At its meeting on August 11, 2003, the Nevada State Contractors Board adjudicated cases against four (4) licensed contractors.

**Robert Quinn,** license number 54046 (Residential and Small Commercial) based out of Reno, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for substandard workmanship; failure to comply with a notice to correct; failure to provide required disclosures; failure to notify homeowner of rights pertaining to the Residential Recovery Fund; and willful disregard of plans or specifications. A permanent letter of reprimand was placed in licensee's file; licensee was fined \$4,000 and assessed the cost of investigation.

Angel Electric, license number 42580 (Electrical Contracting) based out of Reno, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for substandard workmanship; failure to comply with a notice to correct; failure to include license number and monetary limit on a contract or proposal; failure to obtain a building permit; and failure to notify homeowner of rights pertaining to the Residential Recovery Fund. The Board suspended the license of Angel Electric; licensee was fined \$2,000 and assessed the cost of investigation.

Axis Environmental, license number 50419 (Asbestos and Lead Paint Removal) based out of Reno, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for abandonment of a construction project; failure to prosecute a construction project causing material injury; a fraudulent or deceitful act committed in the capacity of a contractor; failure to include license number and monetary limit on a contract or proposal; failure to establish financial responsibility; failure to cooperate in the investigation of a complaint; and failure to keep in force a bond or cash deposit. The Board revoked the license of Axis Environmental.

**Prestige Flooring**, license number 51452 (Finishing Floors) based out of Sun Valley, Nevada was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for substandard workmanship and failure to comply with a notice to correct. The licensee was fined \$1,000 and assessed a portion of the cost of investigation.

The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare through licensing and regulation of the construction industry. Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor's license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine of up to \$10,000 per offense, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.
