## THE NEVADA STATE CONTRACTORS BOARD TAKES DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST TWO LICENSED CONTRACTORS

**Reno**, NV – At its meeting on December 4, 2002, the Nevada State Contractors Board adjudicated cases against two (2) licensed contractors.

Clark Brothers Plumbing and Heating, license number 48464 (Plumbing and Heating) based out of Sparks, NV was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to pay for materials or services. The Board revoked the license of Clark Brothers Plumbing and Heating.

Westland Construction, license number 20727 (Residential and Small Commercial) based out of Gardnerville, NV was found in violation of Nevada Revised Statute 624 for failure to include monetary limit on a contract or proposal. A one-year letter of reprimand was placed in licensee's file.

The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare through licensing and regulation of the construction industry. Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor's license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine of up to \$10,000 per offense, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.

The Board will convene next in Henderson, NV on December 16-17, 2002.
