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CONTRACTORS BOARD ASSESSES FINES, REDUCES MONETARY LIMITS AT JULY DISCIPLINARY HEARINGS

RENO and HENDERSON, Nev. – The Nevada State Contractors Board took disciplinary action against licensed contractors for violations of Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 624 during its July hearings. To comply with social distancing and related emergency directives, all Board hearings are conducted online via Zoom, in compliance with Open Meeting Law requirements.

Bottari Construction, license number 37459 (residential and small commercial) based out of Lamoille, Nev., was found in violation of disregarding plans, specifications, laws or regulations; failing to include the monetary license limit or license number on a contract or proposal; failing to comply with a notice to correct; failing to provide notice to the owner regarding the Residential Recovery Fund; failing to provide required disclosures under NRS 624.600; and substandard workmanship. The licensee was fined \$2,350, assessed investigative costs, and ordered to pay restitution in the amount of \$27,000.

Stonewater Construction, LLC, license number 77419 (general engineering) based out of Las Vegas, Nev., was found in violation of failing to comply with and respond to a written request by the Board; failing to maintain a bond; and failing to establish financial responsibility. The licensee was fined \$1,500 and ordered to pay investigative costs.

Atlantis Pool & Spa, LLC, license number 70842 (commercial and residential pools) based out of Las Vegas, Nev., was found in violation of abandoning a construction project; failing to include the monetary license limit or license number on a contract or proposal; failing to take corrective action; wrongfully diverting money for a use other than that for which it was received; failing to prosecute a construction project thereby causing material injury to another; failing to comply with and respond to an order/request of the Board; acting as a contractor without possessing any other license required by the State or political subdivision of the State; failing to establish financial responsibility; and failing to provide required disclosures. The licensee was fined \$5,000 and assessed investigative costs. The monetary limit of license number 70842 was reduced to \$1.325 million.

The A C Guys, LLC, license number 75730 (refrigeration and air conditioning) based out of Las Vegas, Nev., was found in violation of failing to comply with a notice to correct; failing to comply with a request for information; and failing to provide notice to the owner regarding the Residential Recovery Fund. Licensee was fined \$300 and assessed investigative costs.

Andy Anderson Company, LLC, dba A Team Plumbing, license numbers 69170 (plumbing) and 69171 (installing equipment to treat water) based out of Las Vegas, Nev., were found in violation of disregarding the State's industrial insurance laws and failing to pay for materials or services. The licensee's licenses remain suspended and the monetary limits on license numbers 69170 and 69171 were both reduced to \$10,000. Licensee was fined \$1,500 and assessed investigative costs.

The Nevada State Contractors Board is committed to protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare through licensing and regulation of the construction industry. Under Nevada Revised Statutes, a licensee is subject to disciplinary action by



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the Board for failure to comply with the requirements of the laws or regulations governing contractors. Violations may result in Board action against the contractor's license. The State Contractors Board has the power to regulate contractors and discipline licensees who violate NRS 624. Disciplinary action may consist of a fine, order corrective action, suspension, revocation or other action.

NRS 624.212(7) allows an unlicensed individual who was issued a cease and desist order to petition the Board in writing to lift or alter the order within 15 days after receiving the cease and desist order. Upon receipt of this request, the Board will schedule an administrative hearing to review the facts and make a determination on the validity of the cease and desist order and assess any fines or costs that may be associated with the investigation.
